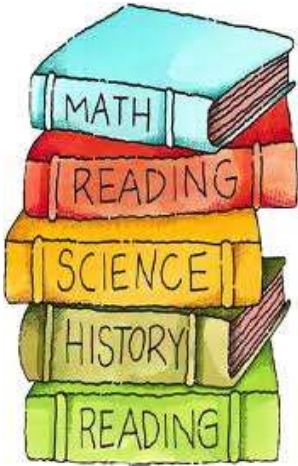


2017 – 2018 Terrace Community Middle School 6th Grade Instructional Materials
