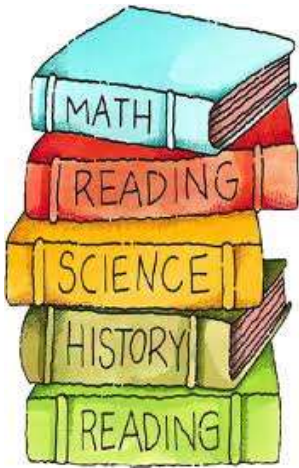


2020-2021 Terrace Community Middle School 8th Grade Instructional Materials
