COURSE REQUIREMENTS

This course's grade is calculated from 4 components: homework, class work, quizzes and chapter tests.

Grading System for Quarter Grade:

1. Homework	15%
2. Class Work	15%
3. Quizzes	20%
4. Chapter Tests	50%

GRADING SYSTEM for Semester Grade:

Quarters I & II average Grade + High school Credit Semester Exam = Semester Grade

75% + 25% = 100%

Semester final exams are mandatory for high school credit courses.

Welcome to Spanish I! This class is a high school credit course with demanding expectations. In order to receive full high school credit, students must pass a Hillsborough County Spanish Mid-term and Spanish Final Exam. In addition, students are required to actively participate during lessons, fine-tune speaking, listening and writing skills. Students will also be expected to complete projects and other assignments throughout the year.

Each chapter test will require students to write short stories in Spanish. This is mandated by the county to pass the class, and meet the Florida Standards. Therefore, I will be assigning writing prompts in order to prepare your child for the high school credit exam. Please note students are not allowed to use Spanish translators such as Google translate for these assignments. An online or literal translation from English to Spanish is considered cheating (resulting in a zero for that assignment) and I will know if they use it. They can only use it as a reference tool in finding meaning to isolated words, not complete phrases or sentences.

Late Assignments: Absolutely NO late assignments will be accepted (except by school policy). An assignment is considered late after I have collected the assignment during class.

Materials: ¡Así se dice! Spanish I Workbook, Composition Notebook, pencils, erasers, three-prong plastic folder.

CLASSROOM EXPECTATIONS:

Students are expected to observe proper classroom etiquette. This code of behavior must be followed, so that class activities can be carried out effectively. In general, please refrain from behaving in such ways that would interfere or disrupt class activities or show disrespect for your fellow classmates. All specific questions about classroom behavior should be referenced to in the student handbook. Violations of the student code of conduct will invoke a measured response as dictated by the handbook.

The Spanish I program will use *¡Así se dice! Spanish I* and the corresponding workbook for homework, audio, speaking, and add-on skills. Students are required to have this workbook with them at all times during Spanish class. The workbook will be available to purchase this week during class. The fee will be: \$17. Please send in a check payable to TCMS or cash in an envelope labeled Spanish Workbook 8th grade and it must be turned in to me during class time. The due date for this fee is Tuesday, August 15th.

For the most part, I will speak to the students in Spanish so that they get used to the target language's usage. Interestingly, I am a native Spanish speaker from Paraguay and I hold a Bachelor's Degree in Elementary School K-6 and a Master's Degree in Curriculum Instruction & Technology both from USF. I also hold a Professional Educator Certificate with a K-12 Spanish & ESOL endorsement. This is my fifth year at TCMS. I am so excited to continue working at this prestigious school. I am very confident that your child will enjoy this class and will understand the importance of mastering a second language.

During the first day of class, students will be provided with explanations of classroom rules and expectations. Please read, sign and return these forms with your child and make sure that they fully understand them. Remember that communication is the key to ensure your child's success.
